In God's kindness, we've had a strong start to the academic year (check out <a href="the video!">the video!</a>) We're feeling more organised than previous years and have set up some good structures that help us to keep track of new and returning students.



 The GBU National Conference went well, with good bible talks focused on the Kingdom of God. Students seemed to engage well with Em's seminar on 'Christian dating', which focused on pursuing 'holiness' as the guiding principle in relationships. How vital it is to teach from the bible on topics so pertinent to university students- especially when the world's message is so drastically different!



Here in Coimbra, we'd have an influx of new students join the GBU- some
 Christian, some uncertain and some exploring faith. One seeking student, B,
 joined the weekly bible talk last week because a Christian friend from another city
 encouraged her to go! She seems eager to learn more about Jesus. Join us in

• This semester's weekly Bible talks are exploring the theme "Why Jesus is Good News For..." covering topics like university life, my worries and anxieties, my loneliness, my guilt, history, politics, and money. There will be a range of speakers, including Sam. Please pray that each would teach faithfully from God's Word and that students would see how Jesus truly is good news for all who trust in Him. We have been able to reserve an auditorium (pictured) on the main campus for these talks. It's a great space, and enables more students to join. Maybe we'll see the auditorium full one day?!



Earlier this semester, Sam trained online a new cohort of students from GBU groups across Portugal through the Bible Study Leaders Course. The feedback continues to be overwhelmingly positive, with many students saying they feel far more equipped to write and lead Bible studies. Praise God! One student shared, "Learning all these tools to read the Bible has helped me understand it better. I also am now more aware of how to welcome non-Christians to our bible studies. I've already put some things into practice in my GBU group."

### Looking for.... men!

At the moment, around 80% of GBU Coimbra are girls. Many of them are encouraging, mature women who take their faith in Jesus seriously and serve with commitment and humility. What a blessing! But we are really lacking guys like this. You'll probably notice the imbalance in the photos and videos we share from GBU gatherings!

We long to see both men and women discipled and grown in Christ in the GBU, equipped to be servant hearted leaders in their local churches. The lack of mature Christisn men in the GBU reflects a broader reality in many churches across Portugal. This shortage has significant implications for the next generation of elders, leaders, and teachers in local churches. It feels like a bit of a strange thing to ask for prayer... but could you pray God would bring more men to the GBU, whose hearts are willing to be matured in Christ? Do pray for Sam in particular, for wisdom to know how to best encourage and discipline the current guys in the GBU.
